

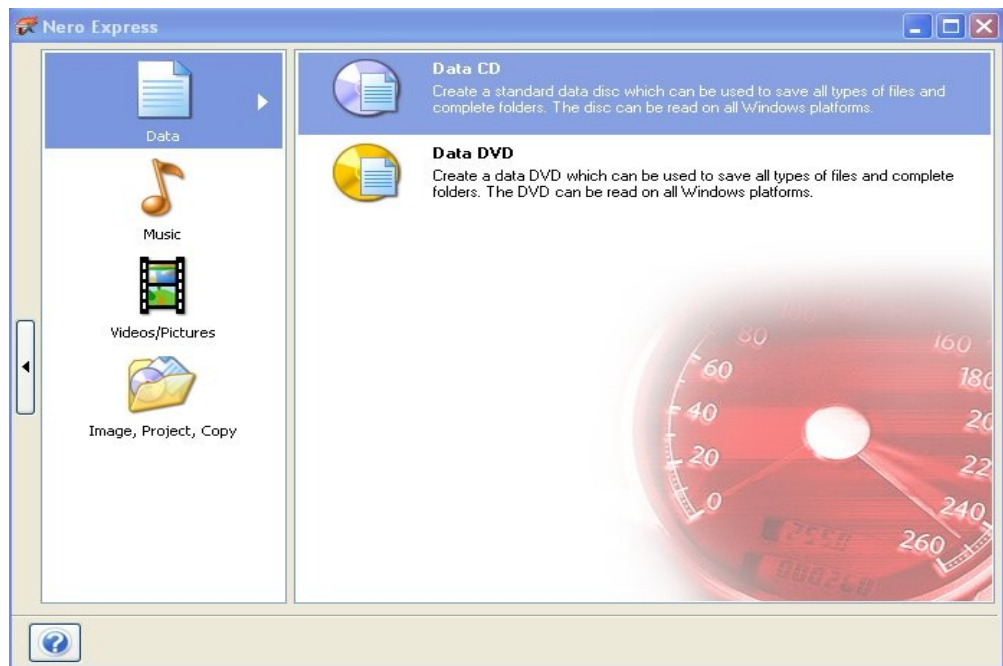
Copying a DVD using Nero Express

*Nero Express uses the same basic procedure as does **ImgBurn** to copy a DVD - specifically it first Reads the Source DVD to create a DVD Image file on the Hard Drive.*

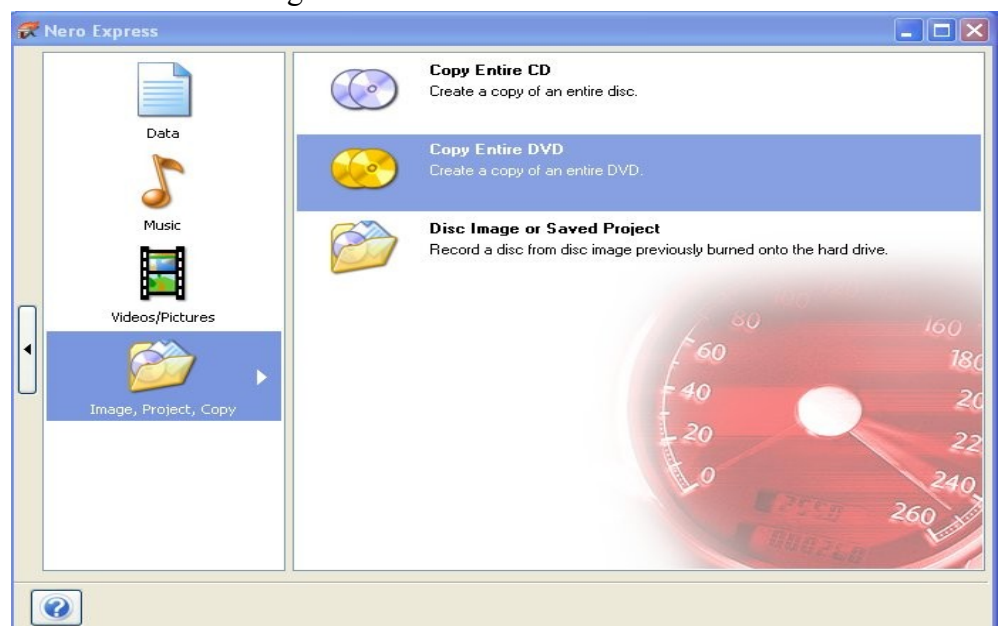
It then Burn (writes) that Image onto the Destination DVD.

Finally there is the option to Verify the Burn – always recommended.

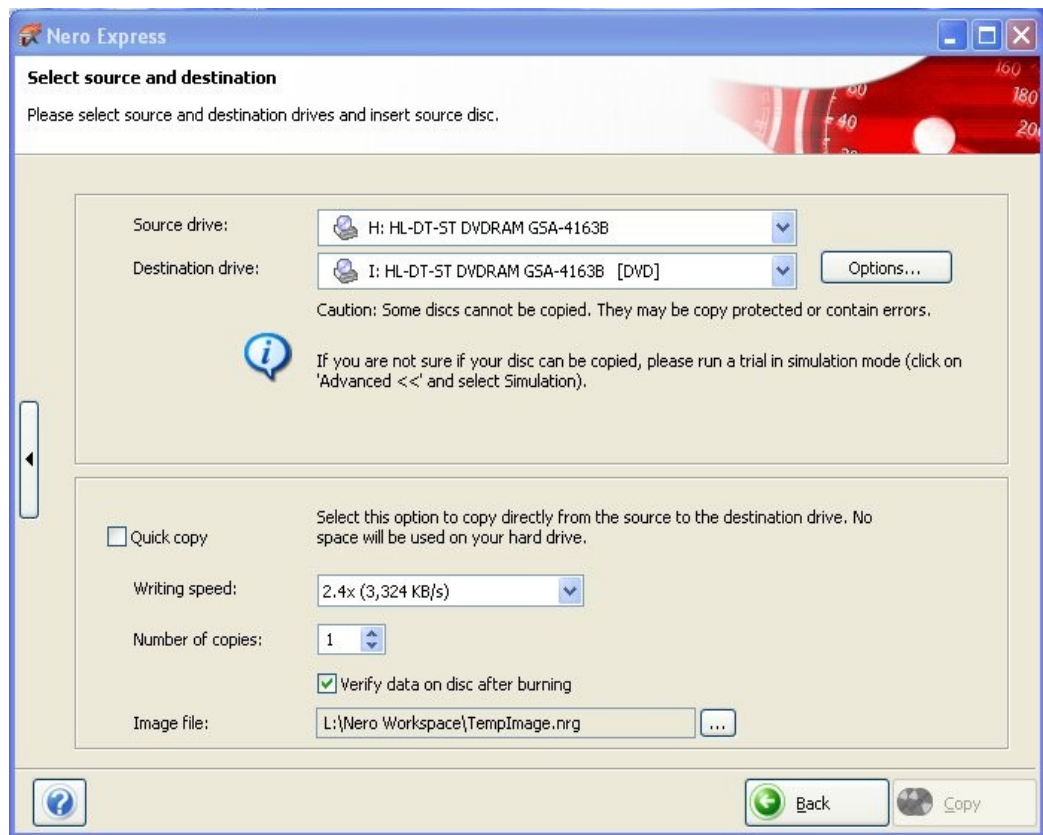
1. Start **Nero Express** and select **Image, Project, Copy** from the Left Column



2. Select **Copy Entire DVD** from the Right side



3. This screen now turn up



Make sure the **DVD Drives for Source and Destination** are correct – meaning they match what is on your machine. With a computer with only one DVD Burner, there is no problem as an Image is used – so the same DVD Drive can be both the Source and the Destination

Set the **Writing Speed** (lower is more reliable, but 8 is fine)

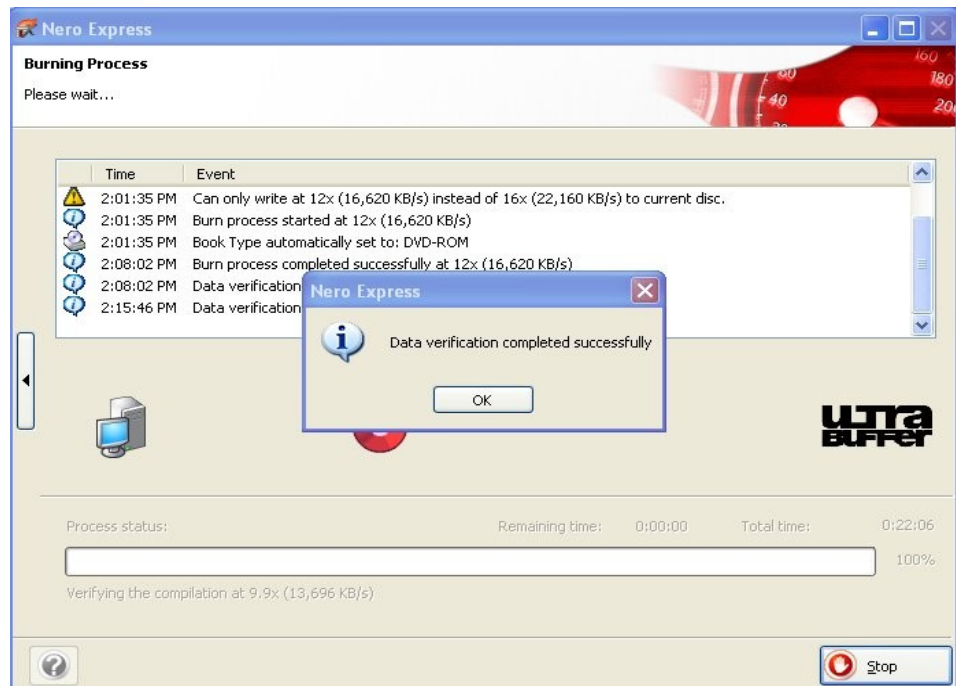
Specify a folder for the **Image file** (somewhere that you know about, and has enough space left on that drive)

Make sure that **Verify** is ticked

As you can see, you can make multiple copies from the one ImageFile.

4. The DVD copying will proceed – initially the creating of the DVD Image on the Hard Drive, then the burning of that Image onto the Destination DVD, and finally the verification.
